Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2015-16 educational progress for the Robbie Hall Parker Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Mrs. Shannon King, principal, for assistance.

For the 2016-17 year, no new Priority or Focus schools were named; some Priority or Focus schools did exit their status because they met the exit criteria. New Reward schools were identified using school rankings and Beating the Odds information. A Focus school is one that has a large achievement gap between the highest and lowest achieving 30% of schools. A Priority school is one whose achievement and growth is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Reward school is one that has achieved one or more of the following distinctions: top 5% of schools on the Top-to-Bottom School Rankings, top 5% of schools making the greatest gains in achievement (improvement metric), or "Beating the Odds" by outperforming the school's predicted ranking and/or similar schools. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases no label is given.

We will continue initiatives we have in place including the continues implementation of the Common Core curriculum, Multi Tiered System of Support, use of Everyday Math program, participation in the Mobymax tutoring program, and the Leader In Me program to develop a culture of achievement for our students, parents and staff. Data from our combined report indicate that we are performing below state averages in some areas. To address this we have adopted the use of the NWEA Assessment program, Mobymax web tutorial, and continue to use research based instructional strategies under the guidance of the Macomb Intermediate School District. In addition, we will continue our mentoring program for our at-risk students.

Robbie Hall Parker Elementary School was awarded continuing accreditation by North Central AdvancED Michigan department of Education in June 2013. This year

we will continue the five-year school improvement cycle. We are implementing goals for reading, writing and math.

Our school implements the common core curriculum adopted by the state of Michigan with a description located on the back of student report cards. Access to a copy of the core curriculum is also available from the principal, teachers or at <http://www.michigan.gov/mde>.

Students are assigned to our school based on district residency and through Schools of Choice applications and approval. Aggregate student achievement results for Parker students for the 2015-2016 M-STEP assessments can be located at www.mischooldata.org.

Our parents continue to support their children and school by attending parent teacher conferences with 90% of parents attending in the fall and 87% in the spring of the 2015-2016 school year.
