- #6 SPECIALTY ENTERPRISES INVOICE - Motion by Mr. Scott, support by Mr. Evilsizer that the Board approve the invoice for Specialty Enterprises for graduation gowns for the alternative ed programs for a total amount of \$11,832.00. These gowns are loaned to students, who return them and then they are re-used in subsequent years. ATS will reimburse the district \$9,600.00 for gowns used by their students. Motion carried 5-2. APPROVAL OF BILLS

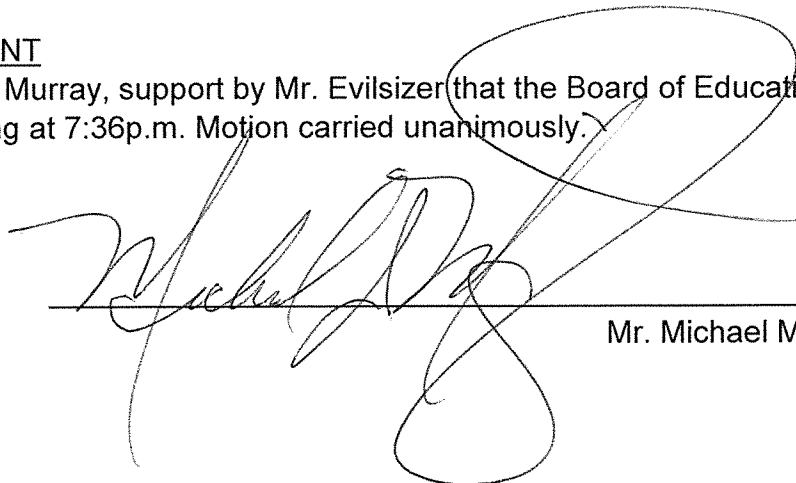
Motion by Mr. Scott, support by Ms. Murray that the Board approve the bills for payment for the period ending April 28, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.
