Motion by Ms. Murray, support by Mr. Manning, that the Board approve the bills for payment for the period ending May 12, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

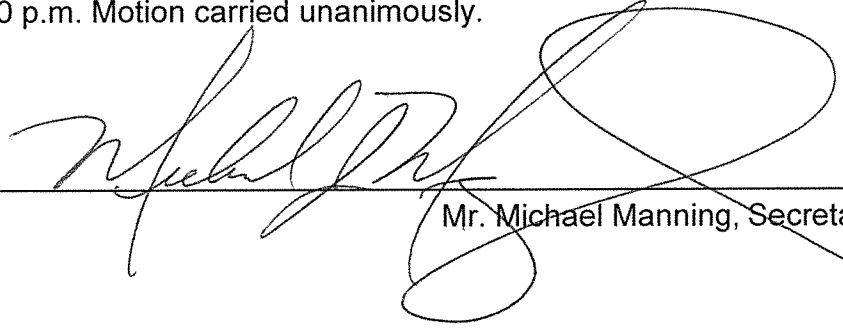
GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENT
