

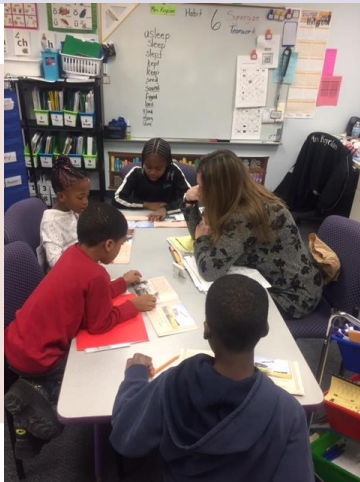

Leaders of the Month

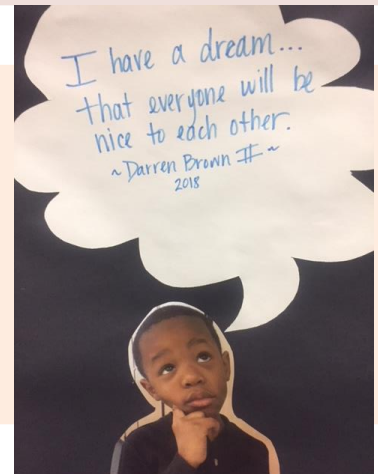

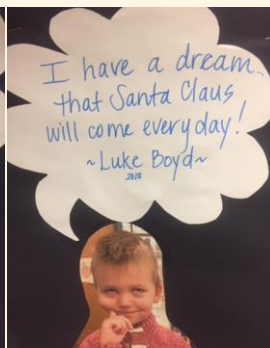
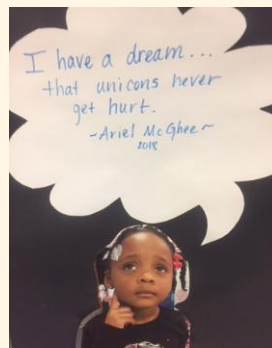
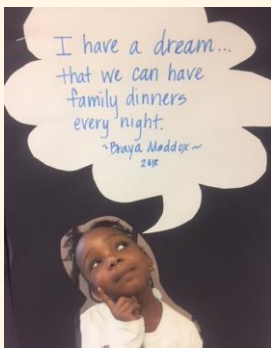
3rd Grade Reading Law

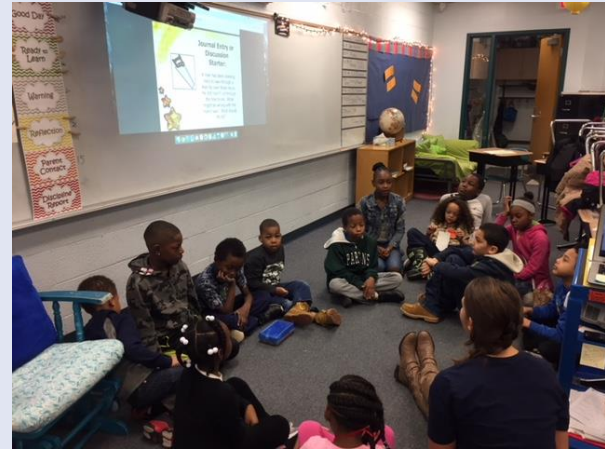


Parker Preschoolers Have A Dream!
